## ORDER

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across an alley in the vicinity of 58th Street and Central Avenue in Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

This order is made upon the condition that said alley is not now actually constructed and open to travel at the point of crossing and this order shall not be deemed an authorization for the construction of an opening of said alley to public use across said spur track.

within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
