It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Railroad Company and its Lessee, Southern Pacific Company, are authorized:

- l. To sell to The Andrew Jergens Company in accordance with the terms of the agreement attached to the application that certain parcel of property described therein and as shown in yellow tint by the map (Drawing No. 16648) attached to the application;
- II. To abandon and remove a spur track 184 feet in length located on the above described property and shown in dashed yellow on the map (Drawing No. 16648) attached to the application;

The authority herein granted is subject to the following conditions:

- Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the completion of the property transfer herein suthorized and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.
- The authorization herein granted shall not (2) be construed as a determination of the value of the property for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
- The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (3) (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
