## <u>ORDER</u>

The People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, are authorized to construct a crossing of State highway 22A at separated grades over the track of Southern Pacific Company near Castroville, Monterey County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit A) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. E-110.0-A. Applicant shall bear construction and maintenance expense. Applicant shall file with the Commission within one hundred and twenty days: (1) a copy of an agreement entered into between the parties relative to the construction and maintenance of said crossing, and (2) plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company. Applicant is also authorized to temporarily relocated existing grade crossing No. E-110.0 during construction of the grade separation and upon completion of the grade separation said temporary crossing No. E-110.0 shall be abolished and closed to public use.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended, or if conditions are not complied with. This order shall be effective immediately.
