BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The Division of Fish and Game, Department of Natural Resources, State of California, is authorized to construct a public road across the Santa Paula Branch of Southern Pacific Company near Fillmore, Ventura County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BE-426.1. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 18 feet and grades of approach not greater than 3 per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign and one Standard No. 3 wigwag (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
