ORDER

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company dis-  
closes that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at  
applicant's station of Briggston for more than a year and that con-  
tinued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is author-  
ized to abandon its non-agency station of Briggston, County of  
Solano, to retire a spur track and unloading platform at said  
station, to eliminate said name from its station records, and to  
cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on  
not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty (30) days after abandonment and removal of  
the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the  
Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not  
exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall  
be effective immediately.
