FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By supplemental application, applicants Guy W. Immel
and Clarence E. Allen request a modification of service reg-
ulation No. 3, of Decision No. 34529 which will permit an ex-
tension of time until January 1, 1942 within which to establish
the passenger stage service between Merced, Atwater and the
United States Airport at Cuba Air Base heretofore authorized by
said Decision No. 34529. Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that service regulation No. 3 of Decision
No. 34529, dated August 26, 1941 appearing at sheet 4 thereof is
hereby amended to read:

"Applicants shall comply with the rules of the Commission's General Orders Nos. 79 and 80 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A by filing, in triplicate, and concurrently making effective, tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission before January 1, 1942 and on not less than two (2) days' notice to the Commission and the public."

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
