BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

By the above numbered application the Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company and its lessee, Union Pacific Railroad Company, seek the Commission's authority to operate over certain crossings at grade over its tracks in the Los Angeles Harbor area.

At the request of the United States Maritime Commission the City of Los Angeles has made a temporary relocation of Dock Street for the purpose of providing additional space for the plant of the California Shipbuilding Corporation, and such relocation required the construction of crossings at grade at three locations across applicant's line of railroad. Due to the infrequency of rail operation it is not considered that automatic signal protection is necessary.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the authority sought should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company and its lessee, Union Pacific Railroad Company, is hereby authorized to operate over its tracks at the following highway crossings at grade:

- Crossing No. 3A-23.99-C
- Crossing No. 3A-24.00-C
- Crossing No. 3A-25.87-C

Subject to the following conditions:

1. Protection at each of these crossings shall be by Standard No. 1 crossing signs (C.O. No. 75-B) installed substantially at the locations shown on the map (Exhibit "A") attached to the application.

2. The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the operation over these crossings as to it may seem right and proper, and to revoke its permission if in its judgment public convenience, necessity or safety demand such action.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
