## OPINION AND ORDER

These applications concern the operation of public utility warehouses situated in Butte County and known as the Riceton Warehouse and the Doty Brick Warehouse. The former is located at Riceton (near Biggs) and the latter at Biggs. Both warehouse businesses have been conducted by H. E. Savage. Leon Brink and H. S. Brink, Jr. propose to acquire interests in said businesses and their facilities from Savage. The Brinks and Savage propose to lease the lands, warehouse structures and equipment belonging to Margaret M. Doty and Jeannette Doty Caldwell which are now used by Savage in his public utility warehouse operations.

It appears that these are matters in which public hearings are not necessary and that the applications should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled applications be and they are hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

l. That within sixty (60) days from the effective date of this order on not less than five (5) days notice to the Commission and to the public tariffs on file with the Commission be supplemented to show the changes of ownership involved herein.

2. That the property herein authorized to be transferred may not be sold, leased or transferred or assigned, nor shall service as a warehousemen be discontinued, unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to the sale, lease, transfer, assignment or discontinuance has first been secured.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from
