O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct three spur tracks at grade across 11th Street in Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. A-89.6-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rail flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. 75-B).

Applicant is authorized to deviate from Section 1-C of General Order No. 26-C and construct said spur tracks in the alley between "B" and "C" Streets with side clearance of not less than 8 feet 6 inches from the north and south lines of said alley.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
