THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission was requested at the hearing of the Second Supplemental Application in above entitled proceeding to approve a supplemental agreement entered into by and between all of the interested parties herein, providing for the payment of \$275 per year to the Committee of Carmel Highlands Water Users, for its expenses. This sum is to be paid the said Committee from the so-called "differential" provided for in Section XIV of the original agreement dated September 7, 1939.





Good cause appearing therefor,
