BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a main line and a crossover track at grade across a county road near Duns-
 muir, Siskiyou County, at the locations described in the application,
 to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. C-320.0. Applicant
 shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction
 shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without
 superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road
 now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of
 approach not exceeding five per cent. Protection shall be by two
 Standard No. 3 wigwags (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order,
 applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authoriza-
 tion shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time
 be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authoriza-
 tion may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or
 safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
