BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct a pedestrian crossing in the vicinity of Meridian Avenue across its Alhambra Line at the location shown in red on the map (A.E. 10977) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6D-7.67-D). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Width of crossing shall be not more than five feet and grades of approach not greater than six per cent. Protection shall be by special pedestrian crossing signs of a type similar to those previously approved for pedestrian crossing protection at other locations on applicant's system.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this Order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This Order shall be effective immediately.
