BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Applicant, Fresno City Lines, Inc., has requested that the route of its passenger stage service between Fresno and U. S. Army Air Base be modified in order to contact the station of the Santa Fe Trailways in Fresno.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a hearing is necessary and that the request should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the description of said route between Fresno and the U. S. Army Air Base, as described in condition (2) of Section II of Decision No. 34404, dated July 8, 1941, be amended to read as follows:

"(2) Subject to the authority of this Commission to change or modify such at any time in the future, conduct such passenger stage operation over and along the following route:

"Commencing at the intersection of Mariposa Street and Broadway, thence easterly along Broadway past the station of the Santa Fe Trailways to Fulton Street, thence along Fulton Street to Fresno Street, thence northerly on Fresno Street to Fresno Avenue, thence north on Fresno Avenue to Shields Avenue, thence east on Shields Avenue to a point about one-fourth of a mile west of Clovis Avenue opposite the Air Base, returning via the same route."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Fresno City Lines, Inc., be and it is hereby authorized to discontinue passenger stage service on Van Ness Avenue between Fresno Street and Mariposa Street in the City of Fresno.

For all other purposes Decision No. 34404 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
