In the Matter of the Application of the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF KERN, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, for an order authorizing the construction of a crossing by the County of Kern over the tracks of the Southern Pacific Railroad in the vicinity of Mile Post No. 348.

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Kern is authorized to construct a county road across the Asphalto Branch of Southern Pacific Company near Buttonwillow, Kern County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BT-348.1. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than 8 per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B).

Upon completion, the publicly used crossings located about one-half miles west and .3 mile east of the crossing herein authorized shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessary or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately,
