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BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The City of Oakland, acting on behalf of the United States Navy is authorized to construct a crossing of a Naval Access Road as an extension of Maritime Street at separated ~~grades~~ ^{grades} over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company in Oakland, Alameda County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit A) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. A-4.0-A. Applicant, United States Navy, shall bear construction and maintenance expense. Applicant shall file with the Commission within one hundred and twenty days: (1) a copy of an agreement entered into between the parties relative to the construction and maintenance of said crossing, and (2) plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company. FTM

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two year, unless time be extended, or if conditions are not complied with. This order shall be effective immediately.
