OPINION AND ORDER

A parcel of land now used by applicant for the storage of supplies is to be acquired by the United States, a notice of intention having been given to this effect. Anticipating that the just compensation involved may be negotiated without incurring the delay incident to a formal condemnation proceeding, the Commission is asked to authorize the consummation of a voluntary sale. It appearing that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that San Diego Gas and Electric Company be and hereby is authorized to convey to the United States of America that certain parcel of real property more particularly described in the application, together with the structures and fixtures thereon, at any time subsequent to the date of this Order. San Diego Gas and Electric Company is directed, within sixty (60) days after making the conveyance above authorized, to file with this Commission a copy of such journal entry or entries as may be made to record the above-mentioned transaction.
