BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

Maron Ebert Randolph having by deed of gift from her father obtained control and possession of the Plymouth Water Works, a public utility serving water for domestic and other purposes in and in the vicinity of the City of Plymouth in the County of Amador, and investigation having disclosed the fact that no other person, individual or firm now has any legal right or claim to said Plymouth Water Works or any portion thereof, and it appearing that a public hearing in this matter is unnecessary, now therefore,

IT IS HEREBY FOUND AS A FACT that Maron Ebert Randolph is now in rightful ownership, control and possession of Plymouth Water Works, situate in and in the vicinity of the City of Plymouth in Amador County, State of California, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Maron Ebert Randolph, operating under the fictitious firm name and style of Plymouth Water Works, be and she is hereby directed as follows:

1. To file with this Commission within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order the new schedule of rates as heretofore directed.

2. Within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, to file with this Commission for its approval four sets of rules and regulations governing relations with her consumers, each set of which shall contain a suitable map or sketch, drawn to an indicated scale upon a sheet approximately 8 1/2 x 11 inches in size, delineating thereupon in distinctive markings the boundaries of the present service area; provided, however, that such map or sketch shall not thereby be considered by this Commission or any other public body as a final or conclusive determination or establishment of the dedicated area of service, or any portion thereof.
  
3. Within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order, to file with this Commission four copies of a comprehensive map drawn to an indicated scale of not less than 400 feet to the inch, upon which shall be delineated correctly by appropriate markings the area served by the utility and its location with reference to the source of water supply and the surrounding territory. This map should be reasonably accurate, show the source and date thereof, and include sufficient data to determine clearly and definitely the location of the various properties comprising the entire utility area of service.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
