O P I N I O N

John W. Hills, an individual operating under the name and style of Chico-Hamilton City-Orland Freight Stage, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order approving the sale and transfer by him to Sacramento-Corning Freight Lines, Ltd., a corporation, of an operative right as a highway common carrier between Chico and Orland and intermediate points via Hamilton City; and Sacramento-Corning Freight Lines, Ltd. has petitioned for authority to purchase and acquire said operating right and hereafter to operate thereunder, the sale and transfer to be in accordance with an agreement, a copy of which, marked Exhibit "A," is attached to the application herein and made a part thereof.

(1) This applicant also possesses operative rights as a passenger stage corporation which are not here involved.

The consideration to be paid for the property herein proposed to be transferred is given as \$1,000, which is alleged to be the value of the intangibles.

The operating right herein referred to was created by Decision No. 17818, dated December 30, 1926, on Application No. 12073. The record shows that under said operative right service has been continuously provided since its inception in 1926.

After a full consideration of this matter, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request for authority for the proposed transfer is in the public interest and that a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

O R D E R

Based upon the foregoing opinion and the Commission's finding,

IT IS ORDERED that John W. Hills is hereby authorized to transfer to Sacramento-Corning Freight Lines, Ltd. the operative right referred to in the foregoing opinion, and Sacramento-Corning Freight Lines, Ltd. is hereby authorized to purchase and acquire said operative right and hereafter to operate thereunder.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicants herein shall comply with the Commission's General Order No. 80 and Part IV of the Commission's General Order No. 93-A by filing, in triplicate, and concurrently making effective, tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission within sixty (60) days from the effective date of this order and upon not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
