BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Harasthy Street and Pacific Highway in San Diego, San Diego County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 2-265.6-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation, and of a width to conform to the portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadways and with grades of approach not exceeding 5 per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this Order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This Order shall be effective immediately.
