The verified application of Pacific Electric Railway Company discloses that no freight business has been handled at applicant's station of Rio Hondo during the past twelve months and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Rio Hondo, to eliminate said name from its station records and to cancel all tariffs applying at said station, on not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
