IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Western Canal Company, a corporation, shall file with this Commission, within fifteen (15) days from the date of this Order, the schedule of rates, rules and regulations filed in connection with the Order of the Commission in its Decision No. 34108, said rates to become effective as of the date of this Order, and to continue in effect pending the establishment of a schedule of permanent rates, rules and regulations, or further Orders by the Commission.
