BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of THE CITY OF BURBANK, a municipal corporation, to close a certain railroad crossing and to construct and maintain a certain railroad crossing.

Application No. 24787.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The City of Burbank is authorized to construct Buena Vista Street across the Valley Line of Southern Pacific Company at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-470.1. Construction expense shall be borne in accordance with the terms of an agreement between applicant and Southern Pacific Company, a copy of which shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date of this order. Applicant shall bear maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 68 feet and grades of approach not greater than 3 per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. 72. Protection shall be by the two automatic crossing signals now in place at the Lincoln Avenue Crossing (Crossing No. B-470.3).

Upon completion, Crossing No. B-470.3, about 750 feet southeast, shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
