SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Minimum rates, rules and regulations heretofore estab-
lished in this proceeding (42 C.R.C. 239, as amended,) for the
transportation of property by city, common and highway carriers,
have been incorporated in City Carriers' Tariff No. 4 - Highway
Carriers' Tariff No. 5. Western Classification No. 69, C.R.C.-W.C.
No. 2, of R. C. Fyfe, Agent, which is required to be used in con-
junction with that tariff to determine charges applicable there-
under, has been reissued to become effective March 17, 1942. In
the new classification (Western Classification No. 70, C.R.C.-W.C.
No. 3, of R. C. Fyfe, Agent) changes have been made in certain
entries, necessitating corresponding changes in the city and high-
way carriers' tariff. At the same time references in that tariff
to Western Classification No. 69 will be changed to Western Classi-
fication No. 70.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that City Carriers' Tariff No. 4 - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 5 (Appendix "A" to Decision No. 32504, as amended, in this proceeding) be and it is hereby amended by substituting therein to become effective March 17, 1942, the revised pages attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, which pages are numbered as follows:

In all other respects said Decision No. 32504, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
