SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Applicants Manuel Artozqui and Frank Artozqui are engaged in the transportation of livestock as highway common carriers under a certificate of public convenience and necessity acquired by them under the authority of the Commission's Decision No. 33916, dated February 18, 1941 and Decision No. 34669, dated October 14, 1941,

By supplemental application, applicants request authority to suspend the above-described operations temporarily for a period of ninety (90) days.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that applicants, Manuel Artozqui and Frank Artozqui, are hereby authorized to suspend temporarily highway common carrier operations acquired by them under the authority of the Commission's Decision No. 33916, dated February 18, 1941 and Decision No. 34669, dated October 14, 1941, until and including May 31, 1942, subject to the condition that

applicants shall immediately file appropriate supplements to their tariffs and time schedules on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public giving effect to the foregoing authority.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
