OPINION AND ORDER

By this application Mare Island Ferry, a common carrier by vessel between Vallejo and Mare Island Navy Yard, seeks authority to enter into an exchange and lease agreement with the City of Martinez whereby applicant's ferry boat "Charles Van Damme" would be exchanged for the ferry boat "Issaquah" owned by the City of Martinez. It is alleged that applicant is under contract with the United States Navy to commence operation of additional vessel schedules between Vallejo and Mare Island Navy Yard and that the "Issaquah" is better suited for this operation than the "Charles Van Damme."

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Mare Island Ferry, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement similar to the agreement hereinabove referred to, a copy of which is attached to the application herein.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
