BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Second Street and a portion of Pacheco Street in Guadalupe, Santa Barbara County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. E-275-8. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two additional Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B) located approximately as shown on print accompanying the application.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
