Bell an undivided twenty-six one hundredths interest; to Alphonzo E. Bell, as Trustee for Minnewa S. Bell, an undivided seven one hundredths interest; to Alphonzo E. Bell, as Trustee for Minnewa Bell Ross, an undivided six one hundredths interest; to Alphonzo E. Bell, as Trustee for Alphonzo E. Bell, Jr., an undivided six one hundredths interest; to Alphonzo E. Bell, as Trustee for Diane Elizabeth Tingle, an undivided three one hundredths interest;

to Alphonzo E. Bell, as Trustee for Ralph Joseph Tingle, Jr., an undivided three one hundredths interest; to Jos. H. Gilliland, an undivided twelve one hundredths interest; to Wm. F. Lyte, an undivided twelve one hundredths interest; and to E. V. Tognazzini, an undivided twenty-five one hundredths interest in the warehouse properties situate in San Luis Obispo and acquired by said Port San Luis Transportation Co. under the authority granted by Decision No. 34852, dated December 16, 1941.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the authority herein granted will become effective upon the date hereof.
