## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

On January 19, 1942 the Commission by its Decision No.34937 granted a certificate to Loren W. Smith, applicant herein, to establish a passenger stage service between his terminal at Third and Main Streets, Pomona, and the encampment of the 108th United States Infantry at the Los Angeles County Fair Grounds, situated in the northwesterly portion of the city of Pomona, as an extension of his present operative rights.

By supplemental application, applicant requests authority to temporarily suspend the foregoing described operation. In support of that request applicant asserts that two days after receiving authority to provide that sorvice the troops in the camp at the Fair Grounds were removed and, as a consequence, there has been no public demand for the service since their removal. He requests authority to suspend the operation until such time as public convenience and necessity may require its re-establishment.

This is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and the authority requested will be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that Loren W. Smith be and he horeby is authorized to suspend passenger stage operations between the

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intersection of Third and Main Streets, and the Los Angeles County Fair Grounds, in the city of Pomona, heretofore authorized by Decision No. 34937, dated January 19, 1942, until March 1, 1943, subject to the provision that applicant shall appropriately supplement his tariffs and time schedules now on file with the Commission showing the effective date of such suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that that service shall be re-established when public convenience and necessity warrants.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
