ORDER

It appears from the above application that the parcel of land owned by Pacific Electric Railway Company, as more particularly described in paragraph III of the application and as shown in tinted red on the drawing (C.E.H. 16782), attached to the application, is no longer necessary for railroad purposes and that its disposition or sale will not inconvenience the passenger or shipping public.

Good Cause Appearing, Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to dispose of said property by sale to Shannahan Brothers, Inc., substantially in accordance with the terms proposed in the application.

Applicant shall, within thirty days thereafter, notify the Commission in writing of the completion of the property transfer herein authorized. This authority shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with.
