FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

San Bernardino Valley Transit Company, by the above-entitled supplemental application, requests authority to temporarily suspend passenger service on its army air depot line. Applicant was granted a certificate by Decision No. 34867, in Application No. 24432, authorizing it to operate as a passenger stage corporation between San Bernardino, Colton and intermediate points, and between San Bernardino and an army air depot to be established approximately two miles east of San Bernardino near the intersection of Cardiff and Tippecanoe Avenues. The service authorized was duly established.

It is alleged in this supplemental application that there has been a delay in the construction and operation of the air depot. Consequently, applicant requests authority to suspend service thereto temporarily until it is needed.

This request seems reasonable and the Commission is of the opinion it should be granted.

O R D E R

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that San Bernardino Valley Transit Company is authorized to discontinue the passenger stage service operating pursuant to the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 34867, in Application No. 24432 between San Bernardino and the army air depot situated near the intersection of Cardiff and Tippecanoe Avenues until Monday, May 18, 1942, providing its tariff and time schedule are amended on not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and the public to show that such service has been suspended temporarily as authorized herein.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
