BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a wye track at grade across 41st Street and Meeker Avenue in Richmond, Contra Costa County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. A-13.6-C and as a portion of Crossing No. A-13.57-C, respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding six per cent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B) at Crossing No. A-13.6-C and one additional Standard No. 1 crossing sign at Crossing No. A-13.57-C. Such additional protection as is necessary will be determined by future order of the Commission.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
