BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company discloses that the amount of business transacted at application's station of Chittenden during the past two years does not justify the continued maintenance of a non-agency station at this point.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Chittenden, County of Santa Cruz, to retire a spur track at said station, to eliminate said name from its stations records, and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
