BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER ORIGINAL

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a drill track at grade across McKinnon Avenue and a spur track and drill track across Newcomb Avenue in San Francisco at the locations described in the application. Said avenues are not open to public travel at the present time and this order shall not be construed as authorizing the opening of McKinnon and Newcomb Avenues across said tracks.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
