BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

[The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a team track and to relocate its track No. 64 at grade across Coutts Street, in the City of San Diego,] at the location described in the application. Coutts Street is not now actually constructed and open to travel at the point of crossing and this order is not an authorization for the construction or opening of said Coutts Street across said tracks. Said tracks shall be so constructed that grades of approach not exceeding 10% will be feasible, in the event that the construction or opening of Coutts Street across said tracks shall hereafter be authorized, and so that said grade crossing may be made safe for the passage thereover of vehicles and other road traffic.

Within 30 days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
