BY THE COMMISSION:

ORIGINALORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Shoup Avenue in San Francisco at the location described in the application. Shoup Avenue is unimproved at the point of crossing and this order shall not be considered as authority to open this avenue at grade across said spur track.

Applicant is also granted exemption from Section 2-C of General Order No. 26-C in so far as the location of the spur track in and along Shoup Avenue, as described in this application, conflicts with the requirements of said section.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
