

Decision No. 35264

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of PACIFIC ELECTRIC RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation, for authority to construct, maintain and operate a spur track at grade upon and across Fernwood Avenue and along, upon and across Beechwood Avenue in the City of Lynwood on its Los Angeles-Santa Ana Line.) Application No. 24893.

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORIGINAL

O R D E R

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade upon and across Fernwood Avenue and along, upon and across Beechwood Avenue in Lynwood, Los Angeles County, at the locations described in the application. The crossing of Fernwood Avenue shall be identified as Crossing No. 6N-9.11-C; the crossing of Beechwood Avenue shall be identified as Crossing No. 6N-9.17-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O.#72, without superelevation, and of widths to conform to the portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadways and with grades of approach not exceeding 3%. Protection at each crossing shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G.O.#75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this Order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This Order shall be effective immediately.
