ORDER**ORIGINAL**

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Second Street and across Camelia Street in Berkeley, Alameda County, at the locations described in the application. The crossing with Camelia Street shall be identified as a portion of Crossing No. A-10.2-C. Second Street is not open to public travel at the point of crossing and this order shall not be construed as authorizing the opening of said street at grade across said spur track. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing with Camelia Street shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B) now in place.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
