OPINION AND ORDER

Southern California Edison Company, Ltd. seeks authority to enter into a written contract with the United States Government through the Federal Works Agency covering supply of electric energy, for general lighting service for office, yard lights and Gas Meter Building and for street lighting purposes to a 600 unit defense housing project at Long Beach, California, designated as Cal-4102-X.

The contract, a copy of which is attached to the Application and marked Exhibit A, is for an initial period of one (1) year and thereafter from year to year until terminated by either party by giving thirty (30) days written notice to the other. The rates therein are in accordance with the rates of the Applicant now on file with this Commission. The contract contains a provision that any increase or decrease in Applicant's rates, if applicable to the service supplied thereunder, may be made effective for such service by proper amendment to the contract. The terms and conditions contained in the contract are substantially the terms and conditions of Applicant now on file with this Commission.

It is noted, however, that reference to this Commission's jurisdiction has been omitted from the contract and the Commission at this time

calls to the attention of both parties to the contract the fact that each may expect the Commission to continue to exercise its jurisdiction over the rates, conditions and terms of service rendered thereunder in accordance with the statutes.

The Commission having considered the request of Applicant and it being of the opinion that the Application should be granted, that a public hearing in the matter is not necessary, and good cause appearing, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Southern California Edison Company, Ltd. is hereby authorized to enter into that certain proposed contract with the United States Government attached to this Application and marked Exhibit A and to render the electric service heretofore designated to the defense housing project designated as Cal-4102-K at the rates and under the terms and conditions set forth in said contract.

Southern California Edison Company, Ltd. shall file two copies of the contract with this Commission within thirty (30) days after its execution.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
