ORDER

Southern Pacific Company and Railway Express Agency, Inc., have requested authority to close their seasonal agencies at Delhi Station and to operate this station as a non-agency. Agency service is now provided at this point during July, August, and September of each year and a statement filed with the application shows that during these months in 1941 but thirty-four carload and three less-than-carload shipments were handled at Delhi, an average of about three a week. California Farm Bureau has indicated that it does not oppose the granting of the application.

Good Cause Appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company and Railway Express Agency, Inc., are authorized to close their agencies at Delhi, Merced County, provided applicants shall continue to operate said station as a non-agency station.
