FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

WHEREAS, the Commission issued its Decision No. 34641 in the matter of the application of Southern California Edison Company Ltd., authorizing said company to enter into a special agreement with The Flintkote Company for the sale of electric energy, dated October 7, 1942; and

WHEREAS, Southern California Edison Company Ltd., under date of April 30, 1942, filed its First Supplemental Application in the above matter, pointing out that The Flintkote Company did not desire to be served under the special agreement, under the conditions imposed by this Commission's order, and asked to continue to be served under the regular published rates, rules and regulations of the Applicant now in effect; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The Flintkote Company be served under the Applicant Company's published rates, rules and regulations now on file with the Railroad Commission of the State of California.
