In the above-entitled application $\mathbb{K}$. $\mathbb{Z}$. Atikinson requects the Commission to issue to him a certisicate of pubinc convenience and necessity authonizing the establishment and operation of a passenger stage service for the transportation of passengers, baggage and shipments of express weighing not to exceed one bundred pounds each on passenger vehicles between diartinez and Concond and intermediate points over two routes, one via Avon anc the other via Pacheco and Mountain Vaew, Contra Costa County.

Applicant seeis that authority as an extersion and enlargement of his present operative raght between Martinez, Denicia, Benicie, Arscnal anc Eenfcia Arsenal Barmacks. No service is proposed loctiny between Vartinez, on one hanc, and the teriftory between Nartinez and the intersection of Armold Elghway and Avoz Boulevard and intermediate points, on the other hand, via efthem d.von or concord.
spplicant proposes to provide appro\%imately seven round tinps dally except Saturdays, Sundays and holidays. Tne proposed oneway and round-trip fares between ifa=tinez and Concord are 25 cents and 45 cents, zespectively. The same fares apply between Martinez and Avon. Fares between the intermedate points proposed
to be served vary from 10 to 20 cente. Applicant also proposes to establish 40- and 50-riee individual commation fares.

In Justification for the autionity sought applicant alleges substantially as follors:

There is now no reasonably direct passenger stage service betreen Hantinez and Concozd. The routes over which appifcant proposes to operate will meet a need for direct and expeditious passenger stage transportation between those cities and to and from intermediate points to Martinez or Concord. The route of Pacifis Greynound Lines between Kartinez and Concord is circuitous. Martinez as the county seat of Contai Costa County. In the transaction of business at that point tine servicc proposed by applicant is recuired by those who have such business and also by the people who are employed there by the County. Your appiscant has received many recuests for the establishment of such service. In adaition, requests have been recelved for service by many who are employed at the Sbell Refinery ar Avon.

The only other carnier serving this general territory is Pacific Greyhound Ines which operates over a route between ikartinez and Concord minch is not as direct as that proposed by applicant. Thit carrie has informed the Commssion, in witing, that it has no objection to the granting of this application.

The Comiscion having carefuily comidered this matter is of the opinion and finds that public convenience and necessity require the establishment and operation of the service proposed by applicant. No public hearing appears to be necessary and tine applicatさon will be granted.

Based upon the findings set forth in the foregoing opinfor
IT IS ORDERED that a certisfcate of public convenisnce
and necessity is hereby granted to K. K. Atkinson authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in section 2-1/4 of the Pubile Ütilities Act, for the trancportation of passergers, bagsage and shipments of expreas weighing not to exceed one hundred pounds on passenger vehicles between Lartinez and Concord and intermediate points, as an extension and eniargement of the operative right created by Decision No. 34519 , dated September 23, 1941, via Avon and Golindo and Via Vountain View, Contra Costa County, and Pacheco, suoject to the following restriction and condition:
(I) No passengers, baggage on express sinali be transported jocaliy between Nartinez, on the one hand, and the terintory betreen Martinez and the inversection of frnold Highway and fivon Boulevard anc intermedate points, on the other hand, either ria Avon or via Concord.
(2) K. K. fikinson, his zuccessors or assigns, may neve= claim before tinis Comission or any court or other public body a value for the authority hereby granted in excess of the actual cost thereon.

IT IS FURTEER ORDERE tiats in the operation of the passenger stage service pursuant to the foregoing certificave, the following service regulations shall be observed:
(1) Applicant shall illie a written acceptance of the certificate hereln granted witinn a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from the effective date hereof.
(2) Applicant shall comply with the rules of the Commssion's General O=dersNo. 79 and No. 80 and Part IV of Generai Order No. 93-A by filing, in triplicate, and concurrently mainig effective tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Comission within sixty (60) days fom the effective date hereot and on not lest than Ifve (5) day's notice to the Commission and the pubic.
(3) Subject to the authority of this Commission to change or modify them at any time by further order, applicant shall conduct passenger stage service pursuant to the certificate herein granted over and along the following routes:
(a) Between Martinez and Concord through Mountain View (Contra Costa County) and Pacheco via unnumbered County Eightway loom as the Lartinez-Wannut Creek Highway to the function of another unnumbered County Etghway approximately due west of concord thence via said County Highway to Concord.
(b) Between Martinez and Concord through Avon via State Route No. 106 between Martinez and Avon and thence between Avon and Concord via unnumbered County Highway known as Avon Boulevard.
(c) Within the city of Martinez as follows:
(1) Via Pacheco Boulevard, Jones Street, Pine Street, and Ward Street.
(iI) Via Pacheco Boulevard, Brown Street, Alhambra Street and Ward Street.
(d) Applicant shall tum five motor vehicles at termini on intermediate points, either in the intersection of the streets or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersection in either direction and to carny passengers as trafice regulations of the political subdivision may require.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
