Comply with the rules of the Commission's General Order No. 79 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A by filing in triplicate, and concurrently making effective tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission, within sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof, and on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public."
