In the Matter of the Application of AUGUST MEYER, doing business under the name of PULLMAN WATER COMPANY, to sell, and of EAST BAY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT, a public corporation, to buy the whole of the system and properties of said Company.

ORDER

In this application August Meyer operating under the fictitious firm name and style of the Pullman Water Company asks this Commission for authority to sell and transfer the water distribution systems and appurtenances thereto serving a portion of the City of Richmond and in the vicinity of the town of San Pablo in Contra Costa County, to the East Bay Municipal Utility District, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that this application should be granted, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that August Meyer, operating under the fictitious firm name and style of the Pullman Water Company, be and he is hereby authorized to sell and transfer on or before July 1, 1942 to the East Bay Municipal Utility District, his public utility water distribution systems and appurtenant properties supplying water service to residents in the City of Richmond and in the vicinity of the town of San Pablo, Contra Costa County, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. On or before the first day of July 1942, August Meyer shall refund all amounts, if any, for deposits made for main extensions, meter or service connections, and for any other purposes and on or before the sixth day of July 1942, he shall file with this Commission a certified statement to the effect that any and all such deposits have been refunded.
2. Within sixty days from the date of this Order, August Meyer shall file with this Commission a certified copy of the final instrument or instruments of conveyance for the properties herein authorized to be transferred.

3. Within sixty days from the date of this Order, August Meyer shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which he actually relinquished control and possession of the properties herein authorized to be sold and transferred.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that upon due compliance with the above terms and conditions, said August Meyer shall thereupon and thereby stand relieved of all further public utility obligations and liabilities in connection with the water systems and appurtenant properties herein authorized to be transferred.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
