BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 35337, dated May 11, 1942, in the above entitled matter, the Commission granted a certificate to Hanford A. Crockard for the operation of a passenger stage service between Auburn and McClellan Field and intermediate points, except Roseville, subject to a restriction that no traffic could be handled except that having point of origin or point of destination at McClellan Field.

Gibson Lines, which provides a passenger stage service between Roseville, McClellan Field, Sacramento and other points, has requested the Commission to amend the order of that decision to provide that no service may be rendered to or from points intermediate to Roseville and McClellan Field in addition to the present restriction on traffic between Roseville and McClellan Field. No public hearing is necessary on this request which appears to be in the public interest and will be granted.

Good cause appearing:

IT IS ORDERED that the first ordering paragraph of the

ORDER of Decision No. 35337, dated May 11, 1942, in the above entitled proceeding is amended to read as follows:

"IT IS ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and it hereby is granted to Hanford A. Crockard, an individual, authorizing establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation as defined in section 2½ of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of passengers and their baggage, between Auburn and McClellan Field (Sacramento Air Depot) and intermediate points except between Roseville and McClellan Field and intermediate points, subject to the following restriction and condition."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 35337 shall in all other respects remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
