O P I N I O N

Cantlay & Tanzola, Inc. has petitioned the Commission for an order approving the sale and transfer by it to Paul Alley, an individual, of highway common carrier operative rights for the transportation of live stock as created by and particularly defined in Decision No. 29195, dated October 14, 1936 and Decision No. 32673, dated December 19, 1939. Paul Alley has petitioned for authority to purchase and acquire those operative rights from Cantlay & Tanzola, Inc. and thereafter to operate thereunder.

The transfer is to be made in accordance with an agreement between the parties a copy of which, marked Exhibit "A", is attached to the application. It appears that the consideration for the transfer involved is \$3000.

After full consideration of this matter the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that the request for authorization for the proposed transfer is in the public interest and that a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

O R D E R

Based upon the foregoing finding,

IT IS ORDERED that Cantlay & Tanzola, Inc., a corporation, is hereby authorized to transfer to Paul Alley, an individual, the operative rights referred to in the foregoing opinion and Paul Alley, an individual, is hereby authorized to purchase and acquire those operative rights and thereafter to operate thereunder.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicants herein shall comply with the rules of the Commission's General Order No. 80 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A by filing, in triplicate, and concurrently making effective, tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission within sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof and on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
