FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 35093, dated March 3, 1942, the Commission licensed Marie Berryhill Warren to engage in the business of a motor carrier transportation agent, subject to a condition that within sixty days from the date of that decision she should provide and file with the Commission a surety bond in the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000). Counsel for said Warren, under date of April 21, 1942, has requested an extension of time until September 1, 1942 within which to comply with that provision, asserting as the reason therefor that circumstances beyond the control of the licensee have made it impossible to establish the business for which the license was issued. Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the time within which Marie Berryhill Warren shall provide and file with the Railroad Commission the surety bond required by the order of Decision No. 35093, in the above-entitled proceeding, is hereby extended to and including September 1, 1942.
