THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Written request having been filed for a supplemental order extending the time for commencement of the service authorized by Decision No. 33804 in the above-entitled proceeding, and it appearing that, because of a bridge washout on the new highway over which such service is to be conducted, the completion of said highway by the Department of Public Works will be delayed approximately four months,

IT IS ORDERED that conditions Nos. 3 and 4 contained in Decision No. 33804 are amended to provide that applicant Pacific Greyhound Lines shall comply with said conditions by commencing service and by filing tariffs and time schedules on or before September 15, 1942 and upon five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public.
