

Decision No. 35480

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, a corporation, for authority to construct, operate and maintain a spur track at grade in and along Eighth Avenue, between L Street and Imperial Avenue, in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California.

O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade in and along Eighth Avenue, between "L" Street and Imperial Avenue, in the City of San Diego, at the location described in the application. The crossing of the easterly roadway of Eighth Avenue by this track shall be identified as Crossing No. 2-268.76-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding 3%.

Within 30 days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
