OPINION AND ORDER

In this application, Water Works of Monta Vista, Ltd., a corporation, engaged in the public utility business of distributing water for domestic and other purposes to the public in the vicinity of Monta Vista, Santa Clara County, California, asks for authority to enter into an agreement granting to The Permanente Metals Corporation the right to install, maintain and operate pumping facilities at the site of the main well of said Water Works and to take surplus water therefrom, and granting also to said The Permanente Metals Corporation an easement over property of said Water Works for the purpose of maintaining water pipe lines.

The proposed agreement limits this new use of water to such amounts as are not required by the Water Works to meet its public utility obligations. Investigation indicates that approval of this agreement is now in the best interests of all parties concerned and that a public hearing on this matter is unnecessary.

Good cause appearing, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Water Works of Monta Vista, Ltd., a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with

The Permanente Metals Corporation, a corporation, for the sale of surplus water, substantially in accordance with the terms and conditions as set forth in the proposed agreement, marked "Exhibit A," attached to the application herein and which is hereby made a part of this Order by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Water Works of Monta Vista, Ltd., shall file with this Commission a certified copy of the agreement as finally executed, together with an exact copy of the easement to be included therein, within thirty (30) days after the execution thereof.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
