ORDER

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a second track at grade across the streets, avenues and boulevard, at the locations shown by red lines upon the drawing No. C.E.C.L. 32-22632 attached to the application and identified as Exhibit "A". A description of the crossings involved together with existing protection and that to be installed is attached hereto as Exhibit "A". Construction in each instance shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without super-elevation, with tops of rails flush with roadways and with grades of approach not exceeding those now in existence.

Shown as a separate description on Exhibit "A" attached hereto is a list of streets which are not now actually constructed and open to travel at the point of crossing, and this order is not an authorization for the construction of opening of said streets to public use across said track. Said track shall be so constructed that reasonable grades of approach will be feasible in the event that the construction of opening of said streets across said track shall hereafter be authorized, and so that said grade crossings may be made safe for the passage thereover of vehicles and other road traffic.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
